#### How Much is "Enough?"

Kathy McHenry of Lutheran Planned Generosity recently reminded us that we are the only ones who can answer that question for ourselves. Only we can honestly know what's enough for our daily lives. Knowing your own "enough" means that you understand what you truly need to live well.

Knowing how much is enough for us isn't selfish—it's wise. It helps us honor God's gifts and resist fear. When we understand our needs, then we can let go of excess and live generously. Once we understand what is enough for our lives, then we know how much we can share. Knowing our own level of "enough" means we are then free to choose how to use our gifts or talents, time, and money in generous ways. Knowing our "enough" opens possibilities as we ask how God can use us to be a blessing to others.

During this season of thankfulness and gratitude, take some time to ask yourself:

"How much is enough- for me, for my family, for a faithful life?

And once you discover your "enough," ask the next question:

How can God use what I have to bless others?

The "Daily 3 + 1" is a simple way to develop an attitude of gratitude.

- Write down three things you are grateful for—big or small.
- Then add one way you can share—
   a kindness, a prayer, an act of
   service, a gift of time, or financial
   support.

Practicing gratitude is a powerful way to live into the promise of "enough." Gratitude shifts our focus from what we lack to what we already have. It opens our hearts to God's daily provision and prepares us to live generously.


