"The Robin and the Chicken" Sung by Burl Ives, from the album "Walt Disney Presents Burl Ives' Animal Folk" from 1963.

A plump little robin flew down from a tree

To hunt for a worm which it happened to see.

A frisky young chicken came scampering by

And gazed at the robin with wondering eye.

Said the chick, "What a queer-looking chicken is that!

Its wings are so long and its body so flat."

While the robin remarked, loud enough to be heard,


"Dear me, an exceedingly strange-looking bird!"

"Can you sing?" Robin asked, and the chicken said "No,"

But asked in return if the robin could crow.

So the bird sought a tree, and the chicken a wall,

And each thought the other knew nothing at all.



As people of God, we are each made unique. It can be so easy to focus on our differences. The robin and the chicken are both birds and share much in common. Yet all they see is what makes them separate, so they go their own ways drawing their own conclusions about the other.

Just as the robin and chicken are both birds, so are all people the same when considered from a spiritual perspective. Romans 3:22-24 reminds us, "There is no difference, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God and are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus." As humans, we can never measure up on our own. People cannot adequately glorify and please God.

As this text reminds us, however, all are justified freely by God's grace. This Easter proclamation still rings through the rafters and out into the world. Let us continue to live this Easter message each day as we let our differences enrich our lives together even as we affirm our common denominator: Jesus Christ died and rose again for all people.

Christ is Risen! You are loved! Alleluia!



- The LCOOR Christian Preschool began in September 1986 with an enrollment of 16 students.
- Today the Preschool has 18 students enrolled in the 4/5 year old Mon.-Thurs. morning program.
- The Director/Teacher is Nikki Landmark with Wendy Kruger as the Classroom Paraprofessional.

The preschool's key emphasis is on the development of socialization skills along with cognitive, language, gross & fine motor skills. Each week a Bible story is shared with the students along with a variety of music and verses. The students also have Chapel time once a month with the Pastors.

The Christian Preschool operates on tuition, special gifts (an example: Thrivent Choice Dollars) and fundraiser profits.




FAITH FORMATION MINISTRY
