Review / Approve June 2023 Treasurer's Report: Actual June income: \$76,087.40. Actual June expenses: \$81,197.10. Budgeted income: \$88,968.26. Budgeted expenses: \$88,968.28. Expenses were \$7,771.16 less than budgeted. Promised and nonpromised giving was down for the month of June. Motion to approve June report made by Monte H. Seconded by Codi M. Motion carried.

Review / Approve July 2023 Treasurer's Report: Actual income for July: \$77,561.30. Budgeted income: \$88,968.26. Actual expenses: \$90,419.59. Budgeted expenses: \$88,968.26. The added expense for July was believed to be for the Office area AC unit. Motion to approve July report made by: Gwen M. Seconded by: Ann D. Motion carried.

 is felt to move forward with the roof project.
